Trick or Treat Tips and Sanity-Savers for a COVID-safe Halloween!

Stay outdoors. Dress in costume with your child and set up a treat station outside your front door, on the driveway or in the yard. Use a candy shoot or a large table with candy displayed for reaching instead of grabbing into a common candy bowl.

Wear a mask! Most costume masks may not be effective at stopping the spread of germs. Matching, complimentary Halloween-themed two-ply face masks that you and your child can wear are available!

Limit the group size. If your child (ok, you!) want to go on a fun filled neighborhood candy-quest, keep their trick-or-treating group to siblings or a close friend or two.

Limit the houses you visit. Limiting the number of houses reduces exposure to others. A few homes on your street, or homes of friends is a great option.

Social distance. Leave lots of space on the block between other trick-or-treaters.
